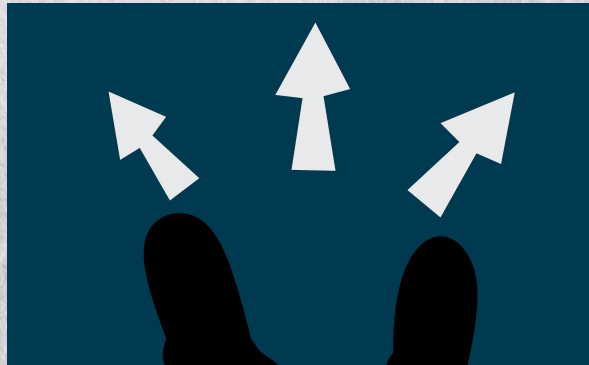


Student Tutorial: Online Course Requests

1. Log student into Skyward
