


Student Tutorial: Online Course Requests

1. Log student into Skyward



2. Click Schedule



3. Click Request Courses for [next school year] in [your school]



4. Request Courses


Selected Courses may have already been pre-loaded by the school. These can only be removed by school personnel.

On the Request Courses tab, there are two options for searching courses:

- Enter 5 digit course key, then click on Search. When course appears, click the course then click Add Course
 OR
- b. Click on a course in Available Courses for [next school year] area, then click Add Course

Courses will appear in the Selected Course area. Use Remove Course to delete courses from your list.

When complete, verify the Total Credits = 8.00 (high school), 7.00 (middle school)




5. Request Alternate Courses

On the Request Alternates tab, there are two options for requesting alternate courses:

- Enter 5 digit course key, then click on Search. When course appears, click the course then click Add Course
 OR
- b. Click on a course in Available Alternate Courses for [next school year] area, then click Add Course

Courses will appear in the Selected Alternate Courses area.

Requested courses have an "R" priority. Alternate courses receive a priority number. Priority can be changed by using the arrow buttons. Use **Remove Course** to delete courses from your list.
