

# 9th grade ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY




Selected Courses may have already been pre-loaded by the school. These can only be removed by school personnel.

On the Request Courses tab, there are two options for searching courses:

Courses will appear in the Selected Course area. Use Remove Course to delete courses from your list.

When complete, verify the Total Credits = 8.00 (high school), 7.00 (middle school)




### 5. Request Alternate Courses

Courses will appear in the Selected Alternate Courses area.

Requested courses have an "R" priority. Alternate courses receive a priority number. Priority can be changed by using the arrow buttons. Use **Remove Course** to delete courses from your list.
